<b>Main Themes</b>	The dangers of false prophets and to encourage perseverance in the faith.

### Characteristics Of False Teachers.

vs. 4	They sneak in unnoticed.
	They turn the grace of God into a license to sin.
	They deny Jesus Christ the Lord and savior
vs. 5-7	They put people in danger of judgment.
vs. 8	Prophecy from their own imaginations.
	They are sexually immoral. (Pollute their own bodies.)
	They reject authority.
	They slander celestial beings. (They rebuke evil spirit and the Devil in their own authority)
vs. 11	They make their own religion of good works like Cain.
	They are greedy for money like Balaam.
	They are bold and rebellious like Korah.
vs. 12	They defile our communion services, and put us in danger of shipwrecking our faith. Eating without fear. (Blemishes or hidden rocks.)
	They are devoid of spiritual refreshment like (clouds without rain).
	They give the appearance of fruit but in reality it is just a show. (autumn trees)
vs. 13	They are restless like the sea and only cast up mud and mire.
	They unreliable guides and are not safe to navigate your life by. (wandering stars)
vs. 14	They are grumblers
	They are faultfinders
	They boast about themselves
	They flatter others for their own advantage.
vs. 18-19	They are scoffers
	They divide the church.
	They follow natural instinct.
	They do not have the Spirit of God.

### Our Defense Against False Prophets.

vs. 17-18	Listen to the words of the Apostles. (Trust the Scriptures)
	Expect false teachers.
vs. 21	Building yourself up in the faith. (Be active in your faith and not passive.)
	Praying in the Holy Spirit. (Pray in the prompting and Power of the Holy Spirit)
	Keep yourself in the love of God. (Preserve in the Faith and Seek to be obedient to Christ).
	Waiting for the mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ.

### Our Offense Against False Prophets.

vs. 3	Contend for the faith once for all delivered to the saints.
vs. 22-23	Have mercy on those who are doubting.
	Save others by snatching them from the fire.
	Hating sin but cautiously loving the sinner.

### Our Sure and Certain Hope.

vs. 24	Is God's sustaining grace.
vs. 25	Is the only God and savior who deserves all praise.
