Chronicles Notes:

1. See last week's study sheet for Chronicles Intro. 2. Chronicles repeats much of Samuel and Kings, but adds a few details. For this reason, we will not read the books of Chronicles through. We will compare stories now and then. 3. Chronicles is from a religious perspective, not just historical/political. It traces JUDAH, not the rest of Israel. 4. The parallel passage of II Samuel 6-24 is I Chronicles 11-21.
