<p>INTRO, JEREMIAH</p>	
<p><i>Yirmeyahu:</i> "Yahweh establishes." A forty-year message of doom bathed in tears, warning hard-hearted Judah of coming trouble. The son of a priest, told by God not to marry, severely persecuted. Preached during the reigns of Josiah through Zedekiah. Contemporary of Zephaniah, Habakkuk, Daniel, Ezekiel, 627-580 BC (6 years after Judah carried to Babylon, as he had warned for 40 years)CHRIST: The BRANCH of 23:1-8; bringer of the NEW COVENANT, 31:31-34. <i>Note the curse on Jehoiachin (Jeconiah, Coniah),chapter 22.His seed leads to Joseph, foster-father of JESUS. But Jesus is the SEED of DAVID and will sit on the THRONE of DAVID through another line of David.See Matthew 1:1-17 and compare to Luke 3:23-38!</i></p>
