He tells them they will be restored to their land. Son of Buzi. Wife dies at final siege of Jerusalem. A Priest.</p> <p>Nebuchadnezzar carried Babylon away in 3 stages: 605, 597, 586 BC. Ezekiel went with the second group. (Daniel there from 605). Ezekiel - Daniel about the same age, both 20 years younger than Jeremiah. Prophesied 592-570, overlapping end of Jeremiah, beginning of Daniel.</p> <p>This and Daniel (and Jonah?) the only prophecies written in foreign lands.
