<p>Daily Readings: Day 1: Book of Hope, 4.1-4.3 Day 2: Book of Hope, 4.4-4.7 Day 3: Book of Hope, 4.8-4.12 Day 4: Book of Hope, 4.13-4.19 Day 5: Book of Hope, 4.20-4.26 Day 6: Book of Hope, 4.27-4.32 Day 7: Book of Hope, 4.33-4.38</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">For INTRO to “BOOK of HOPE”, see Lesson 33 The SYNOPTIC PROBLEM (Halley, p.486, 24th edition) Matthew, Mark, and Luke are called the Synoptic (<i>Greek, “seeing together”</i>) Gospels, because they give the same general view of Christ’s life...Their authorship, mutual relations, and possible connection with a common original is called the “Synoptic problem.”</p> <p>By some it is thought that Mark’s was the earliest of the Gospels, and that Matthew enlarged Mark’s, and that Luke made use of both. Others think that Matthew wrote first, and that Mark made an abridged edition of Matthew’s Gospel.</p> <p>It is not necessary to think that Matthew, Mark or Luke quoted from or in any way made use of the others. The events of Jesus’ life and His sayings were repeated orally for years by the apostles and others, and were in common circulation among Christians. They were the substance of the daily preaching of the apostles.</p> <p>It is likely that, from the beginning, many of these things were written down, some perhaps in a mere fragmentary way, others in more complete form. And when Matthew, Mark, and Luke wrote their Gospels, they chose that which suited their purpose from the fund of knowledge oral or written which was common possession of and in general circulation among Christians, to much of which Matthew had been an eyewitness, and which they themselves had told times without number.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">QUESTIONS, A YEAR of OPPOSITION(4) (Book of Hope Questions 40-59, pp 155-156)</p> <p>I.
