The letters following in this and part of the next lesson, are written from a Roman prison, awaiting trial . INTRO , EPHESIANS

Ephesus is the commercial center of Asia (Minor), and a center of Diana worship as well. The magnificent temple to that goddess was one of the 7 wonders of the ancient world. On both his second and third preaching tour, Paul visited this city, staying nearly 3 years the second time. He put a dent in Diana worship, and had to move on, ending the relationship with the tearful farewell of Acts 20. He wrote to the church while imprisoned in Rome, about A.D. 60. In it he tries to get the Ephesian believers to be aware of their riches in Christ, and to live a life worthy of their calling in Him.

INTRO, COLOSSIANS

While Ephesians focuses on the Body of the church, Colossians is on the Head. Note a similar division of chapters, and similar teachings on the family etc. Colosse was about 100 miles east of Ephesus, a minor town by Paul’s day. The church was founded by Epaphras, who may have heard the Gospel from Paul during his third preaching trip (Acts 19-20). These two letters and Philemon written about 60-61, in a Roman prison. Paul was never in Colosse, but he heard about an approaching heresy that combined Greek, Jewish, and Oriental errors to the exclusion of Christ.
